- 2007 Le Clos Jordanne Claystone Terrace Chardonnay Beamsville Bench VQA (Ontario, Canada)** 85
This Burgundian style wine has a rich nose mixing well integrated oak and stone fruit flavours.
- 2008 Petaluma Piccadilly Adelaide Hills Chardonnay (South Australia, Australia)** 85
This world famous wine offers ripe fruit flavours along with mineral edged acidity.
- 2006 William Fevre Vaillons Chablis Premier Cru (Burgundy, France)** 90
This Chardonnay offers a classic balance of subtle oak notes with apple, citrus and mineral flavours.

2008 Caymus Special Select Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon (California, USA) WS – 94 Pts	250
One of the most sought after California Cabernets. It is dark and intense with deep, rich flavours.	
2009 Marques de Casa Concha Peumo Merlot (Cachapoal, Chile) WS – 90 Pts	50
A bold Merlot with plum, wild berry, spice and mocha aromas.	
2006 Chateau Figeac St-Emilion, Grand Cru Classé (Bordeaux, France) WE – 94 Pts	275
Figeac's uncharacteristically high proportion of Cabernet (35%) lends to its firm tannic finish.	
2008 Petrus Grand Vin de Pomerol (Bordeaux, France) RP – 98 Pts	3,250
Petrus is considered by many to be the greatest red wine in the world. It possesses intense earth, spice box and caramel notes along with a lush texture and sweet tannins.	
2005 Godwin Sonoma Valley Merlot (California, USA)	86
This is a very serious California Merlot with lush, jammy flavours made in the style of great Pomerol.	
2005 Pio Cesare Barolo (Piedmont, Italy) WS – 93 Pts	120
A rich, complex wine with blackberry, mushroom and tar aromas along with firm tannins in the finish.	
2005 Louis Latour Chateau Corton Grancey Corton Grand Cru (Burgundy, France) WS – 92 Pts	175
A complex red wine with an earthy mix of red fruit, spice and liquorice aromas and flavours.	
2005 Marimar Estate Don Miguel Vineyard La Masia Russian River Pinot Noir (California, USA)	88
This distinctly Californian full-bodied style of Pinot Noir packs in cherry, cola and spice flavours.	
2006 Domaine Serene Evenstad Reserve Willamette Valley Pinot Noir (Oregon, USA) RP – 91 Pts	110
This is a top flight Pinot with a generous mix of spicy oak, earth, red berry and mineral tones.	
2006 Fontodi Chianti Classico (Tuscany, Italy) WS – 90 Pts	85
The addition of Cabernet lends this wine some firm drying tannins.	
2005 Antinori Pian Delle Vigne Brunello di Montalcino (Tuscany, Italy) WS – 90 Pts	120
This famed Brunello offers lots of leather, espresso and dark fruit complexity on the nose.	
2004 O Fournier Alfa Spiga Ribera del Duero (Castilla Y Leon, Spain) WE – 90 Pts	95
True to its origins this wine delivers muscular, dense smoky black fruit flavours in an elegant way.
